**Statement: Kalkaringi Meat Supplies**

**Friday, October the 19th 2018**

***The Arnhem Land Progress Aboriginal Corporation (ALPA) is a not-for-profit business and has been providing quality retail and operational services to remote communities in the Northern Territory and Queensland since 1972.***

The Arnhem Land Progress Aboriginal Corporation (ALPA) has been made aware of an indecent photograph of a semi-naked butcher circulating media today.

The man featured in the photograph was an employee of Kalkaringi Meat Supplies and we've been informed that his employment was terminated effective immediately today.

ALPA has informed three stores which were supplied by Kalkaringi Meats to remove all products from their shelves immediately pending an investigation by the Northern Territory Department of Primary Industries.

The Northern Territory Department of Primary Industries has communicated to ALPA that this is a serious breach of policy.

ALPA has taken this matter very seriously and has communicated with the affected stores and has issued clear instructions to ensure any customer who returns Kalkaringi meat products that a full refund will be issued.

ALPA does not envisage this will impact food security and we intend to secure alternative fresh meat supplies until the matter is resolved.
